

1. Enter the cities for your trip.




2. If you click on the calendar icon, you can see the prices for each day. This gets less accurate further out in the calendar.






3. Select your date, click done and when you're returned to the previous screen click on the Search button.



From here, you can see the airline options, where the stops are and the layover durations. You can select your preferred itinerary and go to booking from here, or you can track the prices of flights for your preferred itinerary.

4. To track prices, highlight the track prices button and you'll receive emails when prices fluctuate (a lot of them) until the date of your trip is in the past. Alternatively, you can use the "any dates" button to get emails when prices fluctuate just based on your departure and arrival cities.



The price graph option is more accurate the sooner your flight is. The farther out you go it isn't super reliable unless you are booking your flight at the moment you do the search.
